Intro

An S/4HANA transformation can unlock simplification, better process control, improved data foundations, and a more modern enterprise platform. But the benefits are rarely achieved by technology alone.

Readiness depends on much more than system conversion planning. Organisations need clarity on business outcomes, process standardisation, data ownership, integration complexity, reporting impacts, governance, vendor assumptions, delivery capacity, testing, cutover, and the operating model after go-live.

The **S/4HANA Readiness Assessment Kit** helps organisations assess these areas before major decisions become expensive to change.

Description

Many S/4HANA programmes begin with strong ambition but incomplete readiness. Business cases may assume standardisation before the organisation is aligned. Timelines may underestimate data, integration, testing, change, or decommissioning effort. Vendor proposals may focus on technical delivery while wider enterprise impacts remain underexplored.

This kit provides a practical assessment structure for identifying readiness gaps and programme risks early. It helps leadership and delivery teams ask better questions, challenge assumptions, and create a clearer path from intent to execution.

The assessment covers strategy, business case, process readiness, SAP landscape, data, integration, reporting, security, governance, delivery capacity, vendors, testing, cutover, change readiness, and post-go-live operations.
